Dear Friend,

We are so very grateful for the wonderful support we received from the community for NALZS, a combination zoo and aqarium, among the hardships of Covid-19.

NALZS' initial social media posts resulted in over 200,000 comments, and we were invited to interview with multiple local media outlets. Programming began in early 2020, and we immediately engaged with several local schools. Fundraising started during the summer months with a Facebook Fundraiser that raised \$6,000. In September, we hosted our First Annual NALZS Pals Campaign. Even with the abundance of local charities raising funds simultaneously, we were blessed with over \$7,500 in donations.

As we shared the news about NALZ's with the community, we were frequently asked about the zoo's intended location. We are currently in discussions with several property owners, and answering this question will remain our number one priority in 2021.

We have many more wonderful activities planned for this year as we create "A Zoo for You, North Alabama." Keep an ear out, and we will continue to strive to make you all proud.

### OUR MISSION



## OUR STORY



Our journey started with a daddy-daughter date to the Birmingham Zoo. One of the purposes of zoos is to inspire people. That day, it inspired a question. Watching the peace and joy on the visitors' faces as they connected with the animals caused the question to be asked, "Can Huntsville have a place like this?"

A small group of people got together to research the plausibility of answering that After doing market research, auestion. creating a rough plan, and talking to some zoo executives, the answer came back - Huntsville would be a great place to have a zoo. A nonprofit was formed on August 8th, 2019, and called the North Alabama Zoological Society. A more comprehensive business plan and board of directors were created. Meetings were held with local government officials who shared their excitement to have someone take up this effort. Then on January 9th, 2020 the society put up a billboard announcing an awareness campaign called, "A Zoo For You, North Alabama" to let the public share in the The initial excitement and excitement. support was overwhelming.

## OUR PROGRAMS

### **CONSERVATION**

We are here to be the hub of conservation in our region. We are looking for conservation groups to support with funding, volunteers, and resources. It is our hope that we can strengthen the conservation spirit in the Tennessee River Valley of North Alabama.

### **EDUCATION**

We have created ALSDE based curriculum that can be used for face-to-face or virtual instruction. We believe STEAM-based competitions and contests are a great ways to learn about and understand our natural world. Finally, we are working with other local organizations to put on day camps in the summer of 2021.

### RESEARCH

#### **First Annual Meeting**


Praciting Covid-19 safety guidelines, the Board of Directors and Executive Management Team came together for an annual strategy and development meeting. It was the first time the organization met in person.
